

Attachment B: Beverage Services

You have a choice of the following four beverage services: Hourly, By-the-Drink, Cash, or Hospitality.

I. **Hourly Plan**

Lessee is responsible for their guests' beverages. Lessee may select from a premium bar or a limited bar.

Pricing

Lessee is charged a flat rate per person per hour. This rate is for the entire guest count and is regardless of actual consumption or age of each person. A minimum of two (2) hours of beverage service is required for the purchase of the hourly plan.

A. Premium Bar: Liquor, beer, wine and non-alcoholic beverages. Champagne is not included.

IV. **Hospitality Beverage Service**

Meeting beverage service.

Offering

Includes beverage napkins, disposable cups, bowl of ice and 20 oz coke products - Coke, Diet Coke, Sprite and Dasani water. Beverages are \$2.00 each and service is paid for after the meeting and only on the number of drinks actually consumed.



Bartender & Labor Fees

The confirmed number of guests determines the number of bartenders. In order to provide the best possible service to your guests, the garden requires:

1-50 guests = 1 bartender	201-250 guests = 5 bartenders
51-100 guests = 2 bartenders	251-300 guests = 6 bartenders
101-150 guests = 3 bartenders	301-350 guests = 7 bartenders
151-200 guests = 4 bartenders	351-400 guests = 8 bartenders

If your event will have over 400 attendees, please discuss your needs with the Special Events staff.

Lessee is responsible for bartender fees of \$25.00 per hour per bartender, including set-up and break down with a five (5) hour minimum.

Gratuities

It is the policy of the Garden to allow bar staff to accept tips, if a cash bar is selected. A gratuity container will be placed on the bar during an event in which a cash bar is used.

Taxes & Service Charges

All bars are subject to Georgia State sales tax as required by law and 12% service charge. These charges are already included in the prices stated on page 1 and 3 of this beverage service.

Special Orders

The Atlanta Botanical Garden will be glad to special order alcohol for an event. Lessee must pay for all special orders in advance. Lessee will be charged the full amount of any special order whether or not it is consumed. Unused portions of special orders, opened or unopened, will not leave the premises. No exceptions.

Caterers

The caterer may provide coffee, tea, punch, and ice water. The Atlanta Botanical Garden liquor license requires that ABG provide all alcoholic beverage service, sodas and bottled water. No outside beverages are allowed.

Payment

Lessee must confirm beverage plan no later than 2 weeks prior to the event. A confirmed final guest count is due 7 business days prior to event date. All beverage plans, including bartender labor, will be invoiced within ten (10) days of the event, with full payment due with 30 days of invoice date.

During the event, the Garden reserves the right to refuse alcoholic beverages to an individual that appears intoxicated and or discontinue beverage service should it be deemed necessary. Under no circumstances is anyone allowed to leave Atlanta Botanical Garden premises with alcoholic beverages.
